The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director and the Technical delegate, and having heard from the Team representative, have considered the following matter, determine the following.

N° / Competitor: 93 / PETROGOLD
Session: Qualifying Session 2
Time (fact): 17:15
Fact: Car 93 was allegedly released in an unsafe manner from the pit stop
Offence: Alleged breach of Article 12.1.1 of LES Regulations
Decision: No further Action
Reason: Car 93 made a pit stop and subsequently left the pit lane at the start of the qualifying session. Upon reaching Turn 9, the car experienced an issue with the left-rear wheel, which appeared potentially to be related to the wheel nut not having been sufficiently tightened.

Having considered the available evidence, the Stewards note that Car 93 had travelled through several corners following its pit stop before the issue occurred. The Stewards therefore consider that it cannot be established with sufficient certainty that the incident resulted solely from the wheel nut having been insufficiently tightened, as a mechanical failure or another contributing factor cannot be excluded.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable timelimits.
