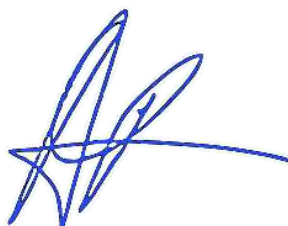
The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having checked the video evidence, having consulted the Driver Advisor and having heard both drivers, have considered the following matter.

N° / Driver: 83 / Charles LAMBERT
Competitor: TRAJECTUS MOTORSPORT
Session: Race 1
Time (fact): 09:40
Fact: Alleged car 83 forcing car 3 wide at turn 1
Offence: Alleged breach of Appendix L Chapter IV Article 2 b) of FIA International Sporting Code
Decision: No further action.
Reason: On the approach to turn 1 car 83 moved to the right to overtake car 3 and was alongside car 3 as they turned into the corner. On the exit of the corner car 83 drifted wide under acceleration and as a result car 3 went off track to avoid contact. However, car 83 then conceded the position to car 3 and hence did not gain any lasting advantage from the manoeuvre.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
